

Sand (Tree soil)

COMMON CROP TYPES

As the name already describes, planting soils are good for planting and landscaping activities

The most suitable plants will be trees, bulbs and shrubs such as Madonna lilies, Mock oranges, Weigela and Lilac.

Definition

Planting soil is a sub-classification of sand soils - predominantly composed of sand, and low levels of silt (<10%) and clay (1%).

Composition

Clay (<1%), silt (9%), sand (83%), and organic matter (7.7%).

Characteristics

Planting soils are characterized by grain sizes of 0.05-2 mm, low to medium fertility, and fast drainage rates.
